

Secret 1:

NMC & Airbase Prime



After cleansing and toning your client's skin, use Airbase Prime to give the perfect base for silicone make-up.

Its moisturising properties make it ideal for everyday use and it is formulated to help ensure your make-up lasts all day.

If your client has particularly dry skin or excessively dry, patchy combination skin, Airbase Prime is the ideal product to equalise the skin's Natural Moisture

Content (NMC) prior to applying Airbase Make-Up.

The biggest secret for creating a flawless foundation is correct skin preparation, ensuring the skin's NMC has been balanced using Airbase Prime.



Secret 2:



Under-Base Contouring

For ultra-soft and super sophisticated contouring, why not try using this celebrity make-up artist secret?

Using your Airbase Make-Up Shading Pad, create sleek cheek contouring and glowing highlights on your model before applying your Airbase Foundation.

Softly mute your highlight and shadow work by lightly hazing over with the foundation colour - giving your model soft, natural and beautiful contouring.

Secret 3:

Dark Under-Eye Pigmentation



Airbrush make-up professionals even use the amazing coverage of Airbase Make-Up to colour correct dark under-eye pigmentation.

Mix 2 drops of Airbase Foundation #1 with 1 drop of Airbase Blush Shade #2 to create a peach tone corrector colour ideal for neutralising blue grey under-eye discolouration.

Important: This colour corrector should be carefully applied to the under-eye area with the Airbase Foundation Brush, an alternative conventional make-up brush or a make-up sponge.



Never use your Airbase Airbrush to apply make-up to the face whilst your model's eyes are open.

Never direct airflow or atomised cosmetics under the lashes of the closed eyes as this may accidentally force the eye open, allowing air and cosmetics to enter the eye.

Never hold the airbrush closer than 10 cm to 13 cm (3 inches to 4 inches) from the closed eyes when applying Airbase Make-Up.

2 drops Airbase Foundation #1 plus 1 drop Airbase Blush Shade #2

Apply to the under-eye area with conventional brushes or sponges.



Secret 4:

Perfect Colour-Matched Foundation



With foundation colours ranging from 00 Porcelain to 06 Ebony, Airbase Make-Up allows the beauty professional to perfectly match their client's skin colour with drop by drop accuracy.

Packed full of Vitamin A and Vitamin E, Airbase is more than just a make-up.

The Vitamin A improves elasticity of the skin and temporarily reduces the appearance of fine lines.

Vitamin E moisturises and repairs. An antioxidant, it acts as an agent to deactivate aggressive free radicals and protects cells from free radical injury.

Simply add your choice of foundation to the colour cup of your Airbase Airbrush and lightly spray a small dot of colour on your client's jaw line to test the colour.



Modifying your foundation colour with Airbase Make-Up is quick and easy. To mix two foundation shades together in the airbrush add your second colour to the airbrush colour cup and simply stir together using an orange stick or cocktail stick, or by 'back bubbling'.

You can even add warmth or a golden glow to your foundation by adding one of the Airbase Blush Shades or Airbase Bronzer.

Top tip: If you need to repeat the make-up again on your client (for example if you are conducting a bridal make-up trial) make a note of both the colours and number of drops you used to create the perfect foundation shade.



Secret 5:

Blitz Your Blemishes!

Airbase Make-Up fans agree that the silicone based foundation colours are ideal for concealing unflattering pigmentation on the skin - even covering up spots and breakouts.

To accurately apply the correct coverage, direct the airbrush at the problem area on the face or body - holding it stationary around 10 cm (3 inches) from the skin.

Press down on the airbrush trigger then gently rock the trigger backwards and forwards to softly pulse Airbase Make-Up Foundation over the blemish.

By using this "on-off" pulsing action, blemishes may be quickly and easily covered, minimising the risk of building up too much product on the skin.



Secret 6:

Blush & Bronzer Colour Tints

Want to give your client that lightly sun-kissed look?

Maybe you want to add a little warmth to the décolleté of your blushing bride...

A top tip from Airbase Make-Up professionals is to create beautiful colour tints by thinning either the Airbase Bronzer or Airbase Blush Shades with a few drops of Airbase Airbrush Thinner and Cleaner.

Mixing this cosmetic grade silicone into either your Bronzer or Blush colour will dilute and soften the intensity of these great colours - allowing you to apply the lightest of colour washes to the skin.

Whether your client is walking up the aisle or off to the beach, this Airbase Make-Up secret is great to add the most subtle of colour tints to the face and body.



Secret 7: Tattoo Cover-Up



Airbase Make-Up can be used by professional make-up artists to quickly and easily cover up tattoos.

Whether you need to cover up your client's tattoo for a photo shoot, special event or wedding - the incredible touch-resistant properties of Airbase Make-Up provides a modern alternative to conventional tattoo camouflage creams.

The colour-matched silicone based airbrush make-up can be gradually layered over the tattooed area to provide long-lasting coverage.


For very darkly pigmented tattoos that can still sometimes show through basic colour-matched foundation cover, try this professional make-up artist secret.

To more effectively cover bluish-black tattoo pigment, spray a light covering of Airbase Foundation #1 over the tattooed area prior to applying your colour matched foundation.

To more effectively cover greenish-black tattoo pigment, spray a light covering of Airbase Blush Shade #2 over the tattooed area prior to applying your colour matched foundation.

This technique works using complimentary colour theory to neutralise the very dark tattoo pigment, diminishing its intensity and making it easier to cover with a colour matched Airbase Make-Up foundation.
